When Jairus's daughter was brought back to life, the people were "completely astonished" (Mark 5:42). According to *Merriam-Webster's* dictionary, *astonish* means "to make a strong impression on (someone) with something unexpected." From His birth to His resurrection, Jesus' life was filled with events and teachings that astounded and dumbfounded all who came in contact with Him. What strong impression has Jesus made on your life? Does Jesus' love for you astonish you? Teach your students to be astonished by Jesus too.
