# Additional Activities for Unit 1

Use these activities for early arrivers, for children who finish activities quickly, and when you are waiting for parents to arrive.

## Learn About Jesus Bulletin Board

Cover a bulletin board with bright-colored background paper. At the top center of the board, attach the picture strip showing Jesus, included on *Resources* sheet 5. Each week, add one of the Unit 1 Focus Cards from sheet 5. Provide a variety of art supplies (drawing paper, markers, glitter gel pens, stickers, etc.) and encourage children to create pictures that show things Jesus did while He lived on earth. Display the drawings on the bulletin board.

## Jesus Is God's Son Game

Have children sit in a circle. Tell kids to think of some of the things Jesus did that show He is God's Son. Start by saying "Jesus is God's Son. He healed an official's son." Have a child next to you say "Jesus is God's Son. He healed an official's son, and He \_\_\_\_\_ (something else Jesus did)." The next child repeats what has been said and adds another thing Jesus did. Keep going until everyone has had a turn. Help kids with ideas as needed. If kids forget what has been said, gently help them remember.

## Fish Plates

On colorful paper, make copies of the fish fins, tails, and heads from the *Resources* CD unit 1 Fish Plate Pattern printable file. (Or copy onto white paper and let kids color their fish.) Give a copy to each child. Kids can cut out the shapes and tape (or glue) them to the backs of small paper plates. Let kids use the plates for a snack time during lesson 4, Jesus Feeds 5,000. Encourage kids to take their fish plates home and tell how Jesus fed a crowd of people.

## Fun Messages

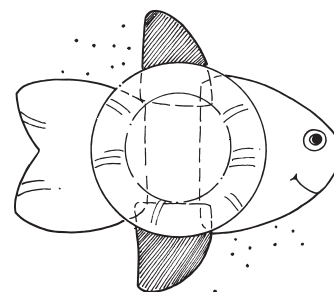
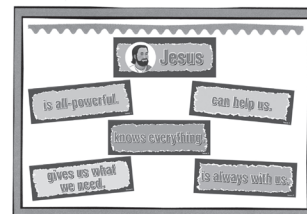
Using colorful paper, prepare strips with this message: "Jesus cares for you—and so do I!" Remind kids of the Bible story of Jesus feeding the 5,000. Provide fish-shaped crackers in small resealable plastic bags. Have kids tape a message strip to each bag of fish crackers. Let each child make two or three bags. They can take the treats home to give to friends and family. Be sure to make a few extra to keep in the classroom for guests who come to your class.
